### Air Conditioning Tune-Up and Inspection



Every year, grass clippings, dirt and bugs build up in your outdoor cooling unit, reducing the efficiency of your central air conditioning system. In addition, corrosion can create holes in your refrigerant lines. What's worse, as your system loses cooling capacity, you probably won't even know it's in trouble until you really need your system to run at full capacity.

A yearly Wilson air conditioning tune-up will save you money, prevent problems, extend the life of your system and keep it operating at peak performance. When we tune up and inspect your system, we will:

- ◆ prepare the whole system for summer operation.
- ◆ inspect and adjust refrigerant controls.
- ◆ inspect and adjust temperature controls.
- ◆ inspect safety controls.
- ◆ check refrigerant charge (refrigerant not included).
- ◆ check belts and adjust tension.
- ◆ clean or replace standard fiberglass filter.
- ◆ check and record operating pressures.
- ◆ inspect and lubricate electric motors.
- ◆ check compressor, evaporator motor, condenser motor, amperage and voltage.
- ◆ clean lint and dirt from air-cooled condensers.
- ◆ record high-pressure and low-pressure readings.
- ◆ record temperature differential.

#### Other

- ◆ A spring tune-up is included for maximum air conditioning efficiency. It may be performed in conjunction with a heating system tune-up.
- ◆ Compressor still under manufacturer's parts warranty replaced with no labor charge if installed by Wilson.
- ◆ All other repairs will be performed at our normal rates for parts and labor.
- ◆ No charge for use of refrigerant recovery equipment on compressor replacement or refrigerant leak repairs.
- ◆ All parts subject to availability.
- ◆ Due to the nature of refrigerant leaks, one hour of coverage will be provided and any additional time will be billed at our regular labor rates.

# General Conditions



1. **Wilson** reserves the right to inspect customer's air conditioning system for eligibility before issuing or renewing a service plan.
2. The length of this agreement is one year. It will automatically renew unless we are notified of cancellation in writing 30 days before the renewal date. However, in the event of cancellation, no refund will be made for any unused portion of the plan.
3. Should you sell your home within your coverage period, the plan can be transferred to the new owners for the remainder of the plan year.
4. There shall be no liability for any reason on the part of **Wilson** for work performed by anyone else, unless such person or persons are authorized in writing by Wilson to perform a specific service.
5. This plan does not cover repairs needed due to acts of God, fire damage, flooding or other water damage, power interruptions or other conditions beyond the control of **Wilson**.
6. For the safety of our technicians and your equipment, **Wilson** will not work on outdoor equipment after dark or in the rain.
7. Labor provided is for service, adjustment, maintenance, replacement of parts, etc. Labor for relocation or replacement of equipment is not provided under this plan.
8. Due to the nature of refrigerant leaks, **Wilson** will provide up to one hour of coverage. Any additional time will be billed at our regular labor rates.
